- Applicants must have a cumulative GPA of 2.5 or higher.
- All applicants must submit a completed application, cover letter outlining what the applicant is submitting, two letters of recommendations (from a teacher, supervisor at a job or volunteer position), high school transcripts, high-resolution digital photo, essay detailing why the applicant should be considered for the Charles W. Herbster Foundation Scholarship and a completed Release of Information Form.
- Applications for the 2018-19 academic year will be accepted through March 2, 2018. (After this date, applications will be submitted to the Charles W. Herbster Foundation Scholarship Committee for review.)
