Policy Reminders

If your child is not going to attend daycare on their scheduled day, please call the center (402.245.3385) by 8 AM, or as soon as you know, even if it is the night before. You can call the center and leave a message at any time. You can also text Lana at 785.850.8490. This will help us plan activities for the day.

When your child does not attend daycare, you must let the director know the reason. If it is a communicable illness we are required by the state of Nebraska to record this in case of other cases breaking out. We assure you that we are taking extra measures to disinfect and clean! We are ready for spring!



Illness Policy

If your child is too sick to attend daycare, please keep him/her home. There is no "sick room" at the center and the best place for a child to recuperate from an illness is at home. If your child is sent to daycare with any of the below symptoms, or develops them during the day, he/she will be sent home. Unfortunately, there are no refunds for days that your child does not attend daycare. There are still costs associated with each childcare spot each day. **Symptoms:** Fever of 100 degrees or greater, green drainage from nose, chronic coughing, rash that isn't treated, pink eye, excessive diarrhea, vomiting, lice or nits.

The attached sheet is our current illness report. If your child becomes ill, a staff member will fill out the form to inform you of what is going on.
