- Volunteer Reminders!
 - 1. NO ONE ALLOWED TO LEAVE UNTIL YOUR SIDE MANAGER HAS DONE A HEAD COUNT.
 - 2. YOUR GROUP IS CONTRACTED FOR THE ENTIRE STADIUM SO WHEN YOUR SIDE IS FINISHED, YOU WILL BE ASKED TO HELP ANY SIDE THAT IS NOT FINISHED.
 - 3. Must bring a form of picture ID to the check-in.
 - 4. All workers must be at least 12 to work.
 - 5. No bringing purses or bags of any kind, as it is hard to keep track of while selling and picking up.
 - 6. No wearing other school colors or logos. You are representing the University of Nebraska.
 Also, please be aware that you are bending and lifting and your clothing must be covering your body. Stay away from spaghetti straps as you may be asked to cover up.
 - 7. ONLY CLOSED TOED SHOES ALLOWED.
 - 8. Workers must stand close to the stack -not out in the aisles because of fire codes.
 - 9. Stack chairs with the EXACT NUMBER ASSIGNED TO YOUR BOOTH. NO ESTIMATIONS CAN BE ALLOWED. REPORT THE NUMBER TO YOUR SIDE MANAGER BEFORE COVERING THE CHAIRS.
 - 10. When the group leader believes everything is returned and stacked correctly, have your side manager check it, THEN SEE IF OTHER SIDES NEED ASSISTANCE. Even though you are assigned one side, we work the entire stadium until we are done. This is because each side sells different

amounts but are paid all the same. No one is allowed to leave until the side manager approves it.

- 11. If you have any questions or suggestions, let your side manager know. We want to make sure we look at all possibilities and options, and handle all questions quickly and efficiently.
- 12. BE COURTEOUS AND HELPFUL! Remember that you not only represent your organization, you represent the University of Nebraska at all times!
- 13. Review the clear bag policy go to Huskers.com and search for the bag policy.
