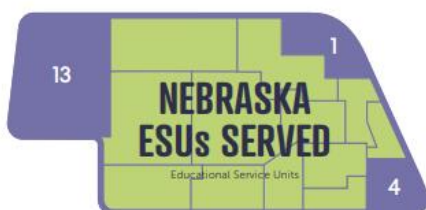
### OUR PARTNERS
