- Athletic Physicals are scheduled for May 16 (last day of school) at **Falls City Family Practice**. These free physicals are for student athletes going into **grades 8th-12th** for the 2023-24 school year. Physical Forms will be sent home with students prior to this date. These forms should be filled out and signed by the parent and student where signatures are required. **Boys Physicals will be 1:00-2:30 PM. Girls Physicals will be 2:30-3:30 PM.**
- **ALL incoming 7th grade students** must have a physical with their family doctor as the State of Nebraska requires all 7th grades to have a more complete physical along with 7th grade immunizations. Physical Forms will be sent home with 7th graders prior to this date. These forms should be filled out and signed by the parent and student where signatures are required. These physicals and updated immunizations records should be turned into the school office by July 1, 2023.
- **ATTENTION HIGH SCHOOL STUDENTS AND PARENTS:** The next ACT test is June 8. The deadline to sign up without a late fee is TODAY. It is recommended that students begin taking the test during their junior year. If you need help signing up, please see Mrs. Dunn. You will need a method of payment with you. As a reminder, an ACT score is not needed for admittance into a community college.
- **Altar Server Summer Event** = All current altar servers are asked to attend the summer training day and Royal's baseball game on Thursday, June 13th. This is only for boys who are currently altar servers and is not a training opportunity for new servers. The event will go from 815am-630pm. 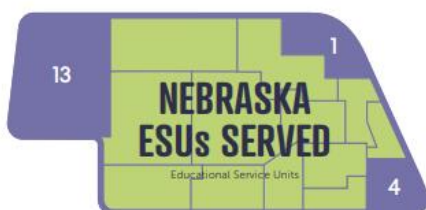
OUR PARTNERS
