Online orders may be placed by registering on the RaiseRight website using Sacred Heart's Enrollment Code (contact Kerry Tramp or email us at sacredheartscripcard@gmail.com.) Orders must be turned in to the school office by 11:00 am or you may contact Kerry Tramp with your order. Order forms are available from the school office or the church vestibule. •Athletic Physicals are the (last day of school) at Falls City Family Practice. These free physicals are for student athletes going into grades 8<sup>th</sup>-12<sup>th</sup> for the 2025-26 school year. Physical Forms will be sent home with students prior to this date. These forms should be filled out and signed by the parent and student where signatures are required. Boys Physicals will be 1:00-2:30 PM. Girls Physicals will be 2:30-3:30 PM.

• ALL incoming 7<sup>th</sup> grade students must have a physical with their family doctor as the State of Nebraska requires all 7<sup>th</sup> graders to have a more complete physical along with 7<sup>th</sup> grade immunizations. Physical Forms will be sent home with next year's 7<sup>th</sup> graders. These forms should be filled out and signed by the parent and student where signatures are required. These physicals and updated immunizations records should be turned into the school office by July 1, 2025.
